

Student Installation Procedure for Civil Designer



This installation is to be carried out on a student's personal computer.

By installing the student version you agree that:

1. This version is for non-commercial purposes only.
2. You understand that student projects cannot be converted to standard projects.
3. You have a PC or laptop running Windows 10 or later, that meets the minimum [system requirements](#).
4. You have permission to install new software and have sufficient access privileges to do so.

Once installed, please note that you will need to request that we extend your trial license to a six month student license. Please email Nikki and attach a copy of your student ID so that we can authorise your license.

After installation you must apply for an authorization license. Select the link that states '**Request Authorization**'. There are also links at the bottom of the page to ask for further assistance if needed.

Once downloaded, the **CD90_Student_Setup.exe** file should reside in the **Downloads Folder** of Windows 11.

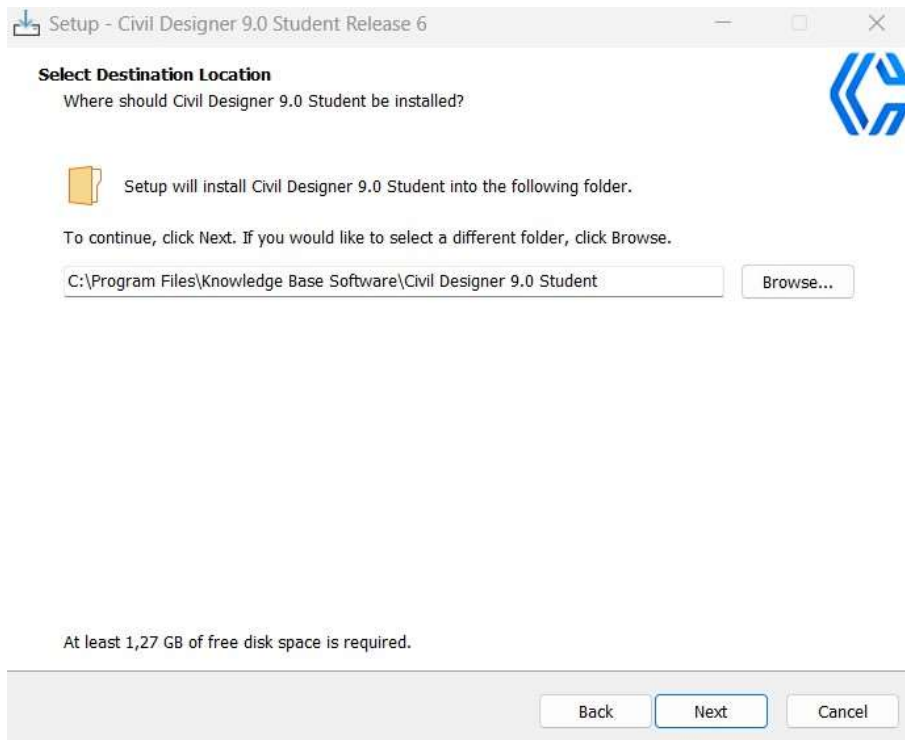
Please follow the steps laid out below:

1. Double click on the CD90_Student_Setup.exe install file and select **Yes**, to allow changes to be made and the installation process to proceed.
2. Click **Yes**, to **uninstall** any previously installed versions of **Civil Designer**
3. You will then get the **Civil Designer 9.0 Student Edition Logo** being displayed.

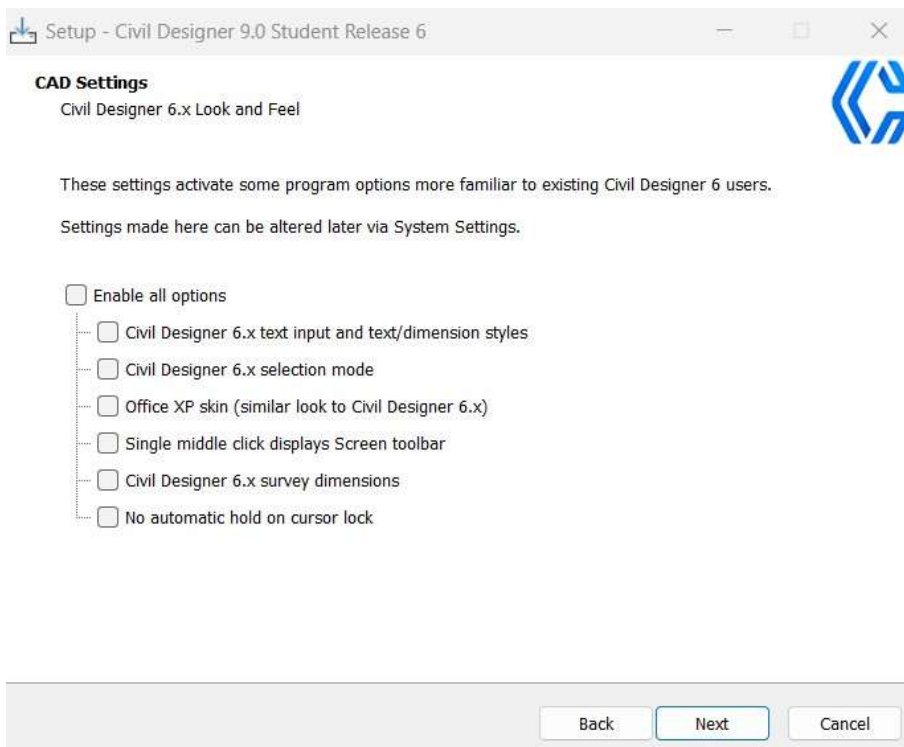


4. Check, "**I accept the agreement**" and click on **Next** to continue.

- Click on **Next** five(5) times to **Path**, set the **Folder Name**, create a **Shortcut**, set the **CAD Toolkits** to **General** and set the **CAD Settings**.
- The **Install** dialog will be displayed showing the selections made to date.



- Click on the **Install** tab and the **Installation** will run, with the **Progress Bar** showing your status.

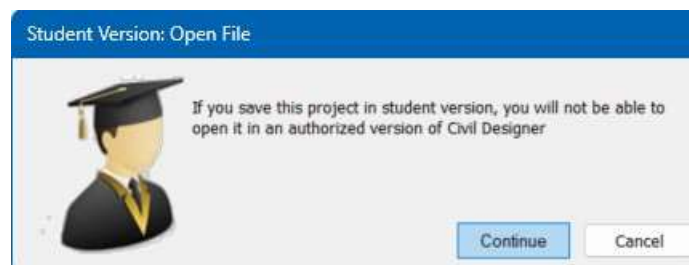


Do not click on Cancel during the Installation and wait for the dialog below to appear.

8. The **Completion** dialog of the '*Student Setup Wizard*' will be displayed, affording us the opportunity to launch **Civil Designer 9.0 Student Edition**.
9. Click on the **Finish Tab** and **Civil Designer** will launch.
10. The **Trial Registration Request Form** will be displayed which now needs to be completed as shown in the example below.





11. Click on **OK** to continue.
12. You will then have a **Trial Period** dialog displayed showing you the remaining time of your seven (7) day *Trial Period*.
13. Click on **Continue** to venture further.
14. You will then be presented with a '**Student Version: Open File**' message as shown.

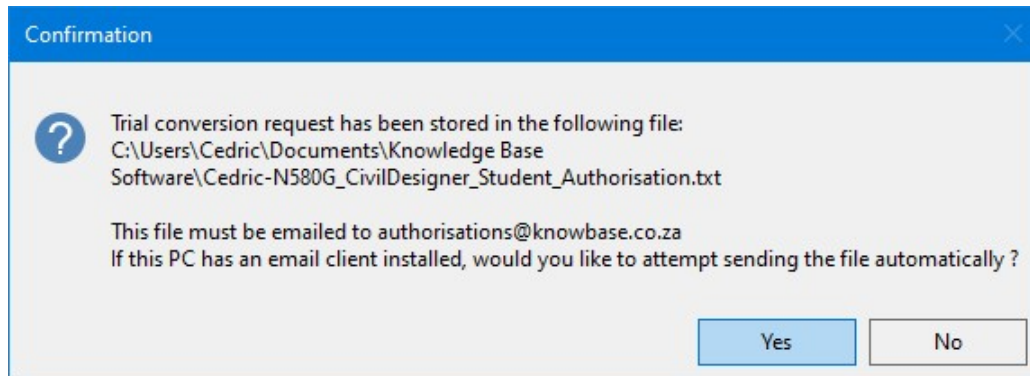


This is very important and needs to be adhered to.

15. Click on **Continue** so you may proceed.



16. Once your seven (7) day **Trial License** expires you will need to convert this to a **Permanent License**.
17. Within **Civil Designer** select **File ► Security ► Convert Trial License...**
-  18. Your populated **Trial Conversion** dialog will once again be displayed.
19. Click on **OK** to continue.
-  20. You will then be presented with a **Confirmation** dialog which needs to be adhered to.



21. Click on **Yes** to attempt sending the **File automatically**. If this attempt fails would you then send the File residing in the folder shown above, manually, using you installed **Email App**.
22. You will then receive an email containing your **Permanent Authorisation Code** and some instructions. The **Authorisation Code** needs to be copied into the allocated slot in the dialog displayed.
23. Your **Civil Designer** is now ready for you to Design further without any disruptions.
